The Master of Divinity is the flagship degree program for theological and ministerial excellence. It provides the skills for biblical interpretation, including competency in Greek and Hebrew, careful theological analysis and wise evaluation of church history, as well as the effective use of these skills in preaching, Bible teaching, church leadership, pastoral counseling and cross-cultural ministry.

These specialized skills are taught by highly competent faculty members who are experts in their fields. In addition, the MDiv program

includes the benefit of personal mentoring with special emphasis on character development and spiritual growth.

Phoenix Seminary's Master of Divinity program offers five areas of ministry concentration: Biblical and Theological Studies, Counseling and Family, Leadership Development, Spiritual Formation and Interdisciplinary Studies.
