

Description: The SKY BLUE FT Scholarship is offered to men and women who are pursuing a call into full-time vocational ministry or full-time Christian counseling.

Who Can Apply: All students pursuing a Master's degree at a full-time pace are eligible to apply for this award.

Award: This award is equal to 100% of tuition, textbooks, and fees for one academic year up to a maximum of 24 credit hours.

Requirements:

- Recipients must complete a minimum of 21 credits per academic year with a minimum of 8 credit hours per semester (Fall and Spring semesters – Summer not required) with a maximum of 24 credits per academic year.
- Recipients must also maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 2.8.
- Recipients must submit the textbooks reimbursement form within 30 days of the start of the semester.
- Recipients must submit a new application for each academic year.

How to Apply: To apply, students must complete a Distinguished Scholarship Application and a [Free Application for Federal Student Aid \(FAFSA\)](#).

Additional Terms and Details:

- This scholarship will be awarded to each recipient for one academic year.
- This award will cover 100% of the cost of tuition for all credit courses, all required textbooks and materials, the General Service Fee, and all required non-credit courses for the fall, spring, and summer semesters up to a maximum of 24 credit hours per academic year.
- This award is subject to enrollment in a minimum of 21 credit hours per academic year (fall, spring, and summer semesters combined) with a minimum of eight credit hours during fall and spring semesters.
 - Awards issued in the spring semester will be subject to enrollment in a minimum of 12 credit hours for the remainder of the academic year (spring and summer semesters combined) with a minimum of eight credit hours during the spring semester.
 - Minimum summer enrollment will be based on the total academic year requirement less the credit hours completed in fall and spring of the same academic year. If a student has met or exceeded the total academic year requirement during the fall and spring semesters, no summer enrollment will be required.
 - Students enrolled in less than the minimum required credit hours will forfeit the award for the current and subsequent semesters. Students who do not successfully complete the required credit hours will forfeit the award for subsequent semesters.
- Due to the value of this award (100% of tuition) it may not be combined with any other discounts, grants, or scholarships issued by Phoenix Seminary. Acceptance of this scholarship will automatically decline all other awards for its duration.

- Recipients must maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 2.8 to remain eligible for the award in the subsequent semesters. Students may reapply once the minimum GPA has been reestablished.
- Recipients must reapply each academic year.
- Students on Academic Probation or Disciplinary Probation will become ineligible for the award in the subsequent semesters. Students may reapply once the probation has been lifted.
- Students may appeal the loss of their scholarship via an official petition. Student may request an appeal form by contacting their Student Service Advisor (SSA). Students will be notified of the decision within two weeks of submitting the appeal. All appeal decisions are final.
- This scholarship is awarded without regard to race, gender, ethnicity, or national origin.
- All scholarship awards are subject to available funding.
